

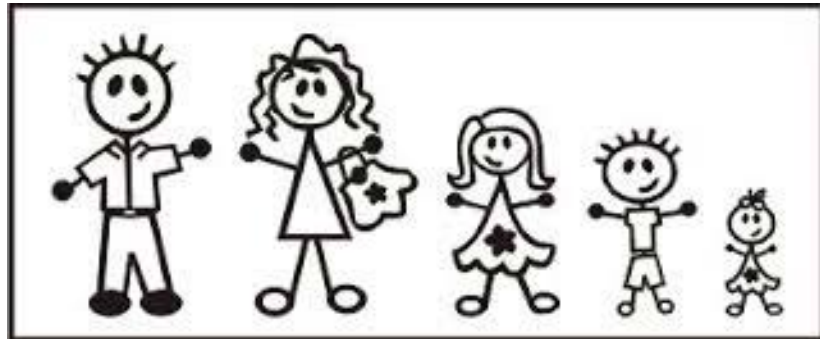


What do you know about Family Practice Medicine?
